

FAQ's – LIFE GROUPS

What is the purpose of Life Groups?

The purpose of Life Groups is to provide an environment where Life Group members can experience authentic community and spiritual growth. They exist to help people take the next steps in their spiritual growth journeys, as well as build relationships with other people who are on similar journeys as themselves, personally and spiritually.

What is the format of Life Groups?

Each group is different. The leader determines the exact format and study of the Life Group. However, each group does consist of 8 to 12 people who provide love, support, friendship, connection and spiritual strength. The format is an informal and comfortable 1½-2 hour gathering at the home of a Host.

What are the requirements to lead a Life Group?

- Leader must have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- Leader must be a member of Life Church. Meaning, they have gone through the membership classes and have been approved as a member.
- Leader must have already been involved in another Life Group for at least one semester.
- Leader must commit to completing Life Group Leadership Training.
- Leader must support the ministry of Life Church without any reservation or addition.
